Subject: FIMER wins the supply of solar inverters for the project "One Giga Project" in Serbia

With a press conference held on February 23, 2012 at the Media Center in Belgrade has been made **official the agreement between Securum Equity Partners of Luxembourg and the Government of the Republic of Serbia for the construction of the world's largest PV Solar Plant of 1 GW power.**

The agreement was formalized in the presence of **Serbian Prime Minister Mirko Cvetkovic, Minister of Environment Oliver Dulic, the Secretary of State Bojan Djuric, Dr. Alessio Colussi of Securum Equity Partners, Dr. Carmelito Denaro of MX Group and of Eng. Ambrogio Fabrizio Carzaniga of FIMER S.p.A.**

The project will be implemented over 4 years (2012 to 2015), will produce green energy that will be sold to neighboring European countries.

The supply for this project will be the largest in the world surpassing the current Californian record of 500 MW, will have **all Italian protagonists.**

The EPC is MX Group which will address, as well as the realization, of even the supply of PV modules. **The supply of the inverter has instead been exclusively committed to FIMER S.p.A.**

FIMER will supply 500 Energy stations of 2000 kW each.

The coming months will define all the operational details of the transaction
